About Project Bruce

Project Bruce is a 3-year community-led development project for the people of Tokomairiro-Milton, Waihola, Taieri Mouth and the wider rural communities.

It's our goal to further develop our communities as resilient and resourceful – taking action for the things we care about. We're building leadership and volunteer participation in our community. We're doing this by asking people what they care about and what they'd like to get involved with.

Project Bruce is hosted by the Milton Community Health Trust. The health trust has an interest in building healthy and resilient communities in the area in which it operates. Project Bruce is governed by a 12-member steering committee consisting of community leaders and representatives from a diverse range of groups within the Bruce ward. The Milton Community Health Trust provides support services (eg management, administration and financial oversight).

Project Bruce is based in the Tokomairiro Community Hub in Milton.

What we've been doing?

Project Bruce is taking a strengths-based approach to community development. A strengths-based perspective focuses on the positive and our communities' aspirations, rather than what's broken and needs fixing. It's an approach that values and builds upon the strengths and assets of the community.

Over the summer of 2017-18, Project Bruce was out and about talking with the people of our area, attending events, shows, fairs, schools and community meetings, and distributing postcards around our community spaces. We've asked people four questions:

- What do you love about your community?
- How could it be better?
- What can you do to make it better?
- And how can we help you to do that?

We received feedback from around 250 people and had conversations with over 560.

Our community plan

This community plan is the result of these conversations. We've grouped community action projects around four core areas:

- Spruce up the Bruce
- Proud Bruce
- Green Bruce
- Sharing Bruce

We've also described how we'll go about putting these projects into action and the values we'll bring to them. This helps us to achieve our overall outcomes.
